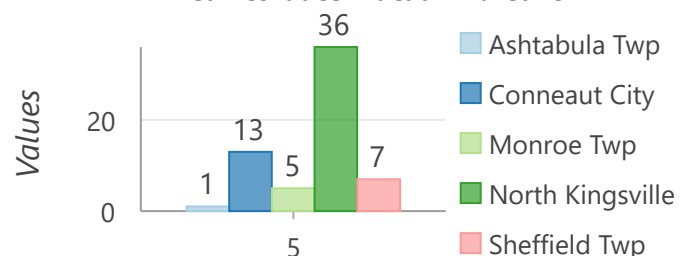

#### Fire & EMS Activities

- Shifts have been covered 100% for all of the last few pay periods and after hours calls are being made with limited mutual aid required.
- Fire Department personnel familiarized themselves with hydrant locations throughout the township and reported inaccessible or obstructed hydrants to the water company.
- The Fire Department continues to sell surplus items on GovDeals allowing us to bring in a small amount of revenue from unused equipment and supplies.



## Road Department

The road crew is keeping busy mowing the park and cemeteries and working on the dirt roads preparing them for dust control. Work is also continually being done of Fox Rd as part of our Ohio Public Works Commission project.

- Brydle, Kingsbury, and River Rd Dust Control - The dust control applied to our gravel roads is more than a liquid solvent to keep the dust down. It is a mixture of tar/oil and stone aggregate that is similar to a chip and seal application. It creates a hard surface that will keep the dust down for an extended period of time compared to a brine or chloride based solution.



- Water at Lulu Falls Cemetery - A new water hydrant for public use was installed at the entrance of the cemetery. The township has been fighting leaks in the system for years and while we may expand the lines for new hydrants, at this time, residents can use this one to get water for flowers and plants.



- Meeting Room Camera - The Township has purchased a camera to broadcast and record our meetings given the COVID-19 group restrictions. Beyond the current crisis, we plan to continue to use the camera to make our meetings accessible to as many people as possible.
